**Title:** Introduction to Remix

**Subject:** English/Writing

**Topic:** Compare Similar Stories

## Stage 1: Desired Results

**Established Goals:** ?

Compare and contrast two or more versions of the same story (e.g., Cinderella stories) by different authors or from different cultures.

**Understandings:** ?

*Students will understand...*

- An introduction to creative freedom
- An introduction to creating stories in their own image
- Critical thinking and listening skills in hearing multiple perspectives

**Essential Questions:** ?

- How do differences in authors or cultures change a story?
- What information needs to be the same for the stories to be the same?

*Students will know...*

- Recognize how details can change perspectives on a story
- Begin thinking of crafting their own twists on a story using Elementari tools

*Students will be able to...*

- Identify the impact different details have on how a story is perceived
- Determine how details they would add to a story would impact it

## Stage 2: Assessment Evidence

**Performance Tasks:** ?

- Students will analyze differences in two similar stories
- Students will share how the differences changed the stories

**Other Evidence:** ?

- Discuss what changes students would make to mold the stories into their own image.

## Stage 3: Learning Plan

**Learning Activities:** ?

- Students will analyze a story written by two separate authors on Elementari.
- Students will read each book.
- Students will summarize the main points of the story.
- Students will locate differences in details between each story.
- Students will discuss how each difference changed the stories.
- Students will repeat these discussions for each detail found.
- Students will discuss how they would change the story and what impact these changes would have.
- Depending on student ability, introduction to the Elementari Remix function can allow students to explore their own creative purposes on these stories.
