Stage 1: Desired Results

Students will understand...

- A variety of elements that make up the structure of a story, including chronology, cause/effect, problems, etc.
- The purpose of structural story elements

Essential Questions: ?

- How do various types of structure drive a story forward?
- How can a story change if the structure is changed?

Students will know...

- The influence structure has on plot outcome (using Elementari's Choose-Your-Own-Adventure stories)
- The purpose of each structural component

Students will be able to...

- Incorporate structural components into their own writing
- Recognize the impact structure (such as cause/effect) can have on a story

- Students will document how their decisions in the Choose Your Own Adventure stories changed the structure/outcome of the stories
