## Stage 1: Desired Results

## Stage 2: Assessment Evidence

## Stage 3: Learning Plan

- Students will analyze a simple Elementari book.

- Students will discuss how they are able to recognize who is talking based on these clues.
- Students will repeat this exercise on each page of the book.
